## **Members are requested to study the following special notes governing competitions.**

All cards taken out on competition days shall be returned by the marker, otherwise the handicap may be reduced. Those not completed should be marked "retired".

Members without a handicap should hand in three scores, each marked and signed by a member. One score must be recorded in a medal competition.

For all competitions, members shall enter their names in the competition computer. In the absence of a starter, members shall take a score card and write clearly their name, date, name of competition and their handicap. Members shall enter their name on the competition tee time sheet to determine the order of play. Competitors may commence play before 3:00pm in Saturday and Sunday competitions. In weekday competitions, competitors may commence play between 7.30am and 7:00pm.

No member shall be considered a qualified competitor unless their name is entered in the competition computer prior to commencing play. All cards must be signed by the marker and counter-signed by the competitor.

In the event of a competition being cancelled owing to weather conditions, it shall be held on the next available alternate date. Notice of the alternate date shall be posted in the clubhouse.

On weekday or Sunday competition days, members shall enter their name on the tee time sheet to determine the order of play. On competition Saturdays, a tee time sheet will be displayed on the competition computer at least one week before the competition.

Intending competitors and non-competitors are requested to place their name against the time at which they wish to play. Non-competitors will not be allowed to reserve a time before 12:00pm.

Members are requested not to introduce visitors between the hours of 7:30am and 3:00pm on competition Saturdays and after 3:00pm on weekday competition days. On competition Saturdays no four-ball matches will be allowed between 7:30am and 3:00pm or until the last competitors have left the first tee at any time. On weekday competition days, members playing in the competition will have priority on the first tee between 4:00pm and 6:30pm. Four ball matches will be allowed to commence play before 3:00pm.

Members playing in match play competitions shall have the opportunity to reserve a tee time in advance. Members are, however, requested to show courtesy when ties are being played.

To enter a competition a member must have a CONGU handicap. If a member has failed to return three medal scores in a season, their handicap will lapse and they must return three qualifying scores before their handicap is reinstated. Members whose handicap has lapsed will not be eligible to compete in any club competition.

All gents competitions to be played from the white tees and all ladies competitions to be played from the red tees on current handicaps as displayed on the competition computer.

## **Procedures for discontinuing / suspending play in competitions**

As a result of more frequent spells of severe weather it is now felt appropriate to document the following procedures in the event of bad weather affecting play. (Ref. Rules 6 – 8 and 33 – 2d)

1. If a player, during the course of the round feels that the course has become unfit for play due to weather conditions, he should under the Rules of Golf mark his ball and then report to Clubhouse for assistance or to wait until the course and weather makes it suitable to re-commence.

2. The club professional or designated starter shall, in the first instance, determine the suspension or resumption of play. In the absence of the club professional or designated starter, the Greens Convenor or Match and Handicap Convenor shall have the authority to make the decision. In the absence of any of the above designated officials, the player has the option of waiting a reasonable period and returning to the course to ascertain if conditions have changed sufficiently enough to allow play to resume. NOTE: personal safety is paramount and careful consideration needs to be made where electrical storms have been in evidence.
3. If a decision is made to suspend play then the players will be notified by the sounding of an air horn:
  - Discontinue play *Immediately* . . . One long prolonged blast of the air horn
  - Discontinue play . . . Three consecutive blasts of the air horn, repeated
  - Resume play . . . Two short blasts of the air horn repeated

(The above signals will be repeated after five minutes to ensure all players have acknowledged the signal)

4. It is emphasised that the decision of the club Professional, Match Secretary or Greens Convenor is regarded as final. This includes decisions on whether a competition is abandoned.

It is hoped that the above will clarify the position to all players and remove any confusion as to the correct action to take in the event of severe weather conditions.

The sounding of the air horn will apply only to organised club competitions, and not to general play, club ties, outings etc, however the *undernoted principles* for suspension of play should be followed by players at all times particularly in the case of a dangerous situation.

**Undernote** to procedures for discontinuing play:

For example there are two principle situations when play could be suspended:

1. Course unplayable . . . if all the area around a hole contains casual water, (rule 33 – 2d) in which case instruction 1. per the above procedures will apply
2. Dangerous situation...electrical storm / lightning, when play must be discontinued immediately

## **1. Procedure when play suspended by committee**

### **1. Procedure when play suspended**

When play is suspended by a designated official, if the players in a match or group are between the play of two holes, they must not continue play until a resumption of play has been ordered. If they have started play of a hole, they may discontinue immediately by marking their ball, or continue play of the hole provided they do so without delay. If the players choose to continue play of the hole they are permitted to subsequently discontinue before finishing the hole, however in any case play **must be discontinued** after the hole is completed.

The players must resume play when a designated official has ordered a resumption of play which would normally be within a 45 minute period. Where no designated officials are in attendance players must take care to allow any conditions to pass before resuming play.

### **2. Suspension of play due to a dangerous situation**

When play is suspended by a designated official (and/or when the horn is sounded due to a dangerous situation) if the players in a match or group are between the play of two holes then they must not continue play until a resumption



of play has been ordered. If they are in process of playing a hole, they must discontinue play immediately and not resume play until a resumption has been ordered. If a player fails to discontinue play immediately in a dangerous situation then he / she is disqualified.

In a dangerous situation all players should immediately seek appropriate shelter

**All members / players should carefully note the signals in the above procedures.**

## Gents

### **MUIRHEAD Trophy**

The competition is played over six rounds on the last Wednesday of April, the second Wednesday of the month from May to July, the first Wednesday of August and a further Wednesday in August. The best four from six stroke play scores to count.

### **ANDERSON Trophy**

The competition is played on the first Saturday of each month from April to September. The best four from six stroke play scores to count.

### **MONTHLY MEDAL**

The competition is played on the second Saturday of April to September. Three classes, viz: 1st Class 11 and under, 2nd Class 12 to 17, 3rd Class 18 to 28, the best four from six stroke play scores to count.

### **GEORGE & ROBERT WHIGHAM Trophy**

This competition is for members of age 55 or over before 1st March and is run in conjunction with the Monthly Medal. Best four of six stroke play scores to count.

### **SUNDAY MEDAL**

Played on third Sunday of months April to August. A monthly winner will be decided by stroke play and will receive a memento.

**Note: Players must be drawn no later than 3:00pm for the above competitions, and from 7:30am to 7:00pm for the Muirhead Trophy**

### **HON. PRESIDENT'S COMPETITION (Gentlemens' Singles)**

The winner will be awarded the Poole Cup for a year. Handicap difference:- Full difference.

### **GENTLEMENS' FOURSOMES**

The winners will be awarded the Rotary Club Rosebowl for a year. Entrants may choose their own partners and competitors must have a current CONGU handicap.

Handicap difference:- Half combined difference

### **GENTLEMENS' FOURBALL (Better Ball)**

The winners will be awarded the Waddell Trophy for a year. Entrants may choose their own partners and competitors must have a current CONGU handicap.

Handicap difference:- Lowest handicap player gives other players 9/10 difference.

### **SENIORS CHAMPIONSHIP**

Ordinary, Veteran or Life Members 55 years of age or over may enter the Seniors matchplay championship. Handicap difference: Full handicap.

NOTE: Entrants should enter their name and pin number on the respective competition entry sheets. Entries close on March 15th. Entrants whose subscriptions are unpaid by the closing date or whose handicap has lapsed will not be included in the draw.

### **STROKE PLAY CHAMPIONSHIP 72 Hole Competition**

First two rounds will be played in conjunction with the Anderson Trophy in May and June. The third and fourth rounds will be played in conjunction with the Anderson Trophy and Monthly Medal in September. The winner will be awarded the Ian Carter Trophy for a year.

## **CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP**

A 36 hole qualifying competition will be played in August. The reigning club champion plus the 15 players with the best aggregate gross scores will qualify for the match play. In the event of a tie, the second 18 hole score, then the best back 9, back 6 and back 3 aggregate in the second 18 hole score will decide.

The qualifying rounds and match play will be played over two weekends in August (dates for all qualifying and match play rounds are indicated in the diary). The final will be played over 36 holes and the winner awarded the Alexander Trophy for a year, and automatic qualification for the following year's match play rounds.

### **FIRST CLASS, BEATTIE & CORLETT Trophies**

Those members wishing to enter the 1st, 2nd or 3rd class championships should enter their names on the entry sheet which will be displayed on the noticeboard approximately 3 weeks prior to the qualifying date. A qualifying round of 18 holes will be played on the same day as the Club Championship qualifying event in August ( see date in diary). The 8 players with the best gross scores in each category (in the event of a ties, qualifiers will be decided by count back of the better inward half) will qualify for the match play rounds. Dates for the match play rounds are indicated in the diary. Members entering the above competitions should ensure they can play on all of the allocated dates.

# Rules for Associate Members

1. Associate members may commence play at any time on:
  - a) Monday to Friday except between 4:30 and 7:00pm.
  - b) Saturday and Sunday after 5:00pm, unless introduced and accompanied by a member.
2. Associate members may introduce visitors on payment of the appropriate charge for each visitor as shown in the membership diary.
3. Associate members shall be entitled to the privileges of the Club with the following exceptions:
  - a) They shall have no voice in the business affairs thereof.
  - b) They shall be eligible to play in designated week day medals for the purposes of retaining a handicap only. They shall not be eligible for competition finals.
  - c) They shall not be eligible for selection to representative teams.
4. The subscription for Associate members will be fixed by the General Committee from time to time as it thinks fit, and will be valid for twelve months from 1st March in any year. Associate membership may be terminated at any time by the General Committee.
5. Associate members must observe at all times the Rules of Golf and the etiquette of the game. All rules regarding the course and the clubhouse as shown in the membership diary must be observed.
6. Any breach of the above rules will render an Associate member liable to instant expulsion without benefit of appeal.

# Fire Evacuation

IN THE EVENT OF A FIRE, OR IF THE FIRE ALARM SOUNDS, MEMBERS SHOULD EXIT THE CLUBHOUSE IN AN ORDERLY MANNER THROUGH THE NEAREST AVAILABLE FIRE EXIT (MAIN ENTRANCE, TWO EXITS IN EACH LOCKER ROOM, THREE EXITS IN LOUNGE, ONE EXIT IN DINING ROOM). MEMBERS SHOULD ASSEMBLE IN THE LOWER CAR PARK UNTIL ADVISED TO RETURN BY A MEMBER OF STAFF. ANY MEMBER DISCOVERING A FIRE SHOULD EITHER ADVISE A MEMBER OF STAFF OR BREAK THE FIRE ALARM GLASS TO ACTIVATE THE ALARM (ACTIVATION POINTS NEAR EACH FIRE EXIT). IF MEMBERS ARE ACCOMPANYING A DISABLED MEMBER OR GUEST, THEY SHOULD PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO THE DISABLED PERSON OR REQUEST ASSISTANCE FROM A MEMBER OF STAFF.

## Introducing Playing Visitors

### Rule 26 of Constitution (revised at AGM 3/2/11)

Members shall have the privilege of introducing visitors on payment of the undernoted charges. Members introducing visitors must play with them and must enter the visitor's name in the visitors book prior to commencement of play and pay the appropriate fee.

At times when the bar and office are not open, the visitors book will be available for signing in the foyer.

On

completion of the round, the fee should be paid at the bar.

The same visitor must not be introduced more than twice within one calendar month, and no more than six days in all during the year, irrespective of the number of members making the introduction.

Spot checks will be made to ensure that these rules are being observed. Any member found to be in breach of these rules will be liable to suspension from the membership.
